The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jerry Gaskin. The minutes from the April 5, 2022, meeting was reviewed, and a motion was made by Gil Shealy to approve the minutes, Graham Dozier seconded they motion. Motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given, the balance in the checking account is \$20.49 and savings is \$2,894.22.

Scott Williams, Soil Conservationist gave an overview of the activity in the Blountstown Field Office. The office has 41 applications in total estimated \$1,758,933. 29 applications estimated cost \$1,447,595 in Calhoun County. 10 applications estimated cost \$200,191 in Liberty County. 2 applications estimated cost of \$111,147 in Franklin County.

A motion was made by Gil Shealy for Chairman, to sign the Memorandum of Agreements and Civil Rights Memorandum of Agreement between Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and the Tupelo Soil and Water Conservation District (CRSWCD). Graham Dozier seconded the motion. Motion carried.
